Reasons for referencing

when you have quoted directly from someone else's work;

when you have paraphrased the work of another author rather when quoted directly from them;

if someone's work or ideas are the source of your argument;

when you have used specific information (e.g. statistics);

when you have used something as background reading which has influenced your ideas.

One author

- e.g. Smith (2013) points out that ...
- 4 More than two authors
- e.g. Smith et al. (2013) talk about ...
- One writer mentioned by another
- e.g. ... (Jenkins 2013, in Owen).
- **+** A number of sources by different authors
- e.g. ...(Maxell, 2013; James, 2012; Smith, 2010).
