Resistance – atsparumas

The capacity to withstand something, esp the body's natural capacity to withstand disease

To eliminate – (pa)šalinti, (pa/iš)naikinti

To remove or get rid of, especially as being in some way undesirable

To breed – veisti(s), dauginti(s)

To produce (offspring); procreate

To reproduce – gimdyti, veistis

To produce one or more other individuals of (a given kind of organism) by some process of generation or propagation, sexual or asexual.

Insecticide – insekticidas, priemonė vabzdžiams naikinti

A substance or preparation used for killing insects.

To eradicate – išnaikinti

To remove or destroy utterly.

To pass on - perduoti

Physically weak, as from age or sickness; frail.

Strain - padermė

To confer – suteikti, duoti

Trial – bandymas
