

CONTEMPORARY SCULPTORS: WORD LIST

• **adjective** - the part of speech that modifies a noun or other substantive by limiting, qualifying, or specifying and distinguished in English morphologically by one of several suffixes, such as *-able*, *-ous*, *-er*, and *-est*, or syntactically by position directly preceding a noun or nominal phrase.

The word "great" in the sentence "We had a great time yesterday" is an adjective.

• adverb - the part of speech that modifies a verb, adjective, or other adverb.

The word "quickly" is an adverb.

• **antique** – very old, ancient.

My family has several antique vases which are inherited throughout generations.

• **cast** - to throw (something, especially something light).

This tree casts a nice shadow in which you can hide from the sun.

• **clay** - A fine-grained, firm earthy material that is plastic when wet and hardens when heated, consisting primarily of hydrated silicates of aluminum and widely used in making bricks, tiles, and pottery.

This pipe is made of clay.

• **contemporary** - Belonging to the same period of time.

This fact is documented by two contemporary sources.

• **definitely** - indisputable; certain

This was a definite victory.

• **dreary** - boring; dull.

Students don't like such dreary tasks as rewriting sentences correctly many times.

• **frequently** – often.

I go shopping very frequently -2 or 3 times a week.

• heap - a group of things placed, thrown, or lying one on another; pile

A heap of stones.

• **heat-resistant** – impervious to the action of heat.

This material is heat-resistant, you can throw it into the fire and it won't melt.

- **order** a condition of logical or comprehensible arrangement among the separate elements of a group. *Put the names in chronological order.*
 - **outstanding** superior to others of its kind; distinguished.

This work of art is outstanding!

• **reflection** - something reflected or the image so produced, as by a mirror.

I can see my reflection on the surface of the water.

• rusted – any of various metallic coatings, especially oxides, formed by corrosion.

I need to buy a new car; my old one is totally rusted.

• **urban** – of, relating to, or located in a city.

The urban population is about 1mln.

• **varnish** – a paint containing a solvent and an oxidizing or evaporating binder, used to coat a surface with a hard, glossy, transparent film.

Cover your wooden floor with varnish and it will shine!
