• assign - to select for a duty or office; appoint for a task.

• **conquer** - to overcome (an enemy, army, etc.); defeat

They have conquered all their enemies in World War I.

• **consider** - to think carefully about.

Consider my advice, it might be helpful.

• **contribution** – the act of giving, devoting oneself for something, helping.

Her contribution to this project was really big.

• equal - having the same quantity, measure, or value as another.

Two plus two equals four.

• establish - to set up; found.

First we have to establish rules and only then start working.

• fair - consistent with rules, logic, or ethics

It is not fair when one person works for all the group.

- **outline** to give the main features or general idea of something.
- participation the act of taking part or sharing in something

Teachers often encourage class participation.

• resolve - to bring to a usually successful conclusion
