

## CIRCLE: WORDLIST

**Arc of a Circle** – apskritimo lankas

A connected section of the circumference of a circle

**Centre of a circle** – apskritimo centras

**Chord** – styga

A line segment whose endpoints lie on the circle

**Circle** - apskritimas

The locus of all points that are a fixed distance from a given point.

**Circumference** - perimetras

A complete circular arc. Circumference also means the distance around the outside of a circle.

**Circular cut out** – skritulio išpjova

**Circular cut off** – skritulio nuopjova

**Compass (pair of compasses)** - skriestuvas

A technical drawing instrument that can be used for inscribing circles or arcs.

**Perimeter** - perimetras

The distance around the outside of a plane figure. For a polygon, the perimeter is the sum of the lengths of the sides.

**Diameter** - diametras

A line segment that contains the center and has its endpoints on the circle. Also, the length of this segment.

**Protractor** – matlankis

An instrument for measuring angles, typically in the form of a flat semicircle marked with degrees along the curved edge.

**Radius - spindulys**

A line segment where the endpoints lie one at the center of a circle and one on the circle. The term also refers to the length of this segment.

**Secant – kirstinė**

An extended chord, a straight line cutting the circle at two points.

**Semicircle – pusapskritimis**

A region bounded by a diameter and an arc lying between the diameter's endpoints. It is a special case of a segment.

**Tangent – tangentas, liestinė**

A straight line that touches the circle at a single point.
