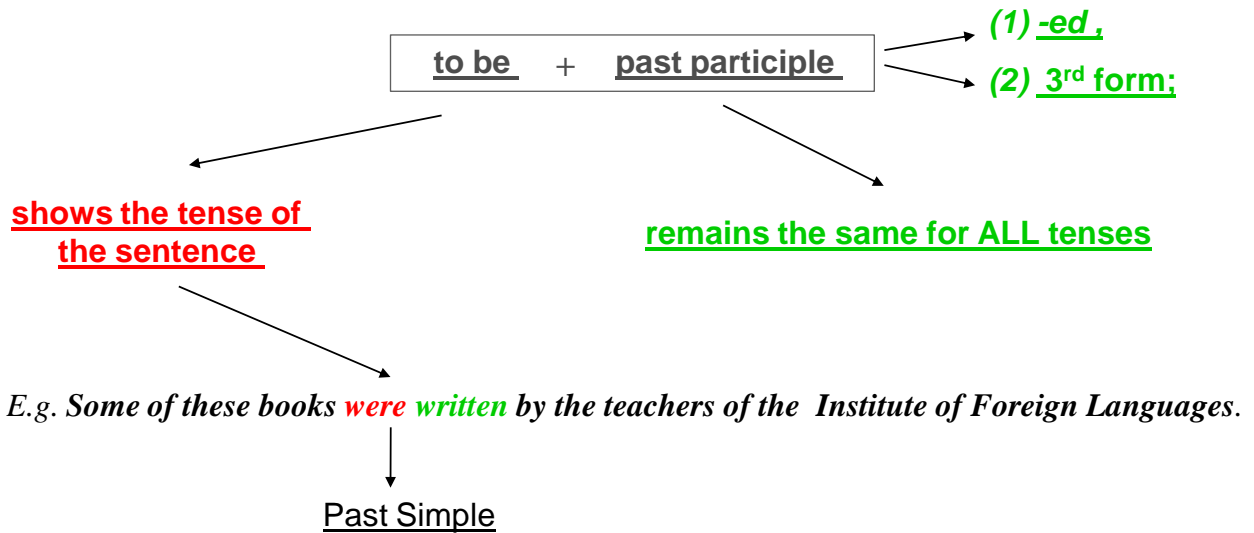




## HOW IS THE PASSIVE FORM MADE?

### Formula of the passive



TENSES	THE ACTIVE	THE PASSIVE
Present Simple	They <b>repair</b> cars.	Cars <b>are repaired</b> .
Present Continuous	They <b>are repairing</b> the car.	The car <b>is being repaired</b> .
Present Perfect	They <b>have repaired</b> the car.	The car <b>has been repaired</b> .
Past Simple	They <b>repaired</b> the car.	The car <b>was repaired</b> .
Past Continuous	They <b>were repairing</b> the car.	The car <b>was being repaired</b> .
Past Perfect	They <b>had repaired</b> the car.	The car <b>had been repaired</b> .
Future Simple	They <b>will repair</b> the car.	The car <b>will be repaired</b> .
Future Perfect	They <b>will have repaired</b> the car.	The car <b>will have been repaired</b> .
"Going to"	They <b>are going to repair</b> the car.	The car <b>is going to be repaired</b> .
Modals	You <b>must repair</b> the car.	The car <b>must be repaired</b> .
Infinitive	They have <b>to repair</b> the car.	The car <b>has to be repaired</b> .
