orchestra – orkestras

A large group of musicians, esp one whose members play a variety of different instruments.

conductor – dirigentas

A person who conducts an orchestra, choir, etc.

audience – žiūrovai

A group of spectators or listeners, esp at a public event such as a concert or play.

the strings – styginiai; stygininkai

- 1. stringed instruments, especially those played with a bow.*
- 2. players on such instruments in an orchestra or band.*

violin – smuikas



viola – altas (muzikos instrumentas)



cello - violončelė



double bass – kontrabosas



woodwind – mediniai mučiamieji instrumentai

1. a musical wind instrument of the group comprising the flutes, clarinets, oboes, bassoons, and occasionally, the saxophones.

2. woodwinds, the section of an orchestra or band comprising the woodwind instruments.

flute – fleita



oboe – obojus



clarinet – klarnetas



bassoon – fagotas



the brass – variniai pučiamieji instrumentai

1. *the large family of wind instruments including the trumpet, trombone, French horn, etc, each consisting of a brass tube blown directly by means of a cup- or funnel-shaped mouthpiece*
2. *(sometimes functioning as plural) instruments of this family forming a section in an orchestra*

the percussion – mušamieji instrumentai

- 1. the section of an orchestra or band comprising the percussion instruments.*
- 2. the percussion instruments themselves.*
