

The Orchestra

The orchestra sits in a semi-circular arrangement with the _____ facing them at the front, with his or her back to the audience. The largest section is the _____ section, which includes the violins, violas, cellos and double bass.

The first violins are on the conductor's _____ with the second violins in the next triangle. The violas are immediately in front of the conductor and the cellos are on the _____ of the conductor in front of the double basses.

The next biggest section is the _____ section. The flute section is behind the violas, next to the second violins, and the oboes are next to them. The _____ are behind the flutes, with the bassoons behind the oboes.

The brass section comprises French horns, trumpets, trombones and _____. They sit behind the woodwind section with the French horns _____ the clarinets, the trumpets in the middle and the trombones and tubas together on the right.

The percussion section is across the middle at the back.

If a _____ is needed it goes on the left of the conductor at the back of the first violins.
