To inherit – paveldėti

Variation – variacija

- 1. The transformation of a melody or theme with changes or elaborations in harmony, rhythm, and melody.
- 2. A varied form of a melody or theme, especially one of a series of such forms developing the capacities of the subject.

Minor – minoras; minorinis

- 1. (of an interval) smaller by a chromatic half step than the corresponding major interval.
- 2. (of a chord) having a minor third between the root and the note next above it.
